









## Role of Ground Control

**Ground Control is a very important role, duties are listed below:**

-  Must always be clearly visible in orange vests and positioned on the fields near spectators - not in the canteen or by the BBQ.
-  Should identify themselves to the match officials before the game (for competition teams).
-  Ensure spectators stay clear of prohibited areas, including:
  - Behind the goals
  - Technical/interchange areas
  - Inside the field boundaries
  - Behind any temporary fencing
-  Assist with field setup and maintenance, including moving or repairing goals, filling holes in the pitch, etc.
-  Monitor and warn coaches, managers, parents, spectators and players for any behaviour that may breach the CRFC 'Code of Conduct and Behaviour.'

**If breaches continue after a warning, the following actions can be taken:**

-  Inform the individual that a formal written complaint can be lodged with the club via [secretary@redbacksoccer.com.au](mailto:secretary@redbacksoccer.com.au)
-  Escalate the issue to the Ground Control Manager or a committee member on duty.
-  If necessary, ask the person(s) to leave the ground. If they refuse, the police may be contacted as a last resort to have them removed.
